\* This grading scale will be used for all homework, projects, presentations, quizzes, and tests.

\* **All assignments** are to be handed in on the date they are due.

- If an assignment is not done (or if it does not meet teacher's expectations), the student will be required to report to the ELT room (during lunch period) until it is completed
  - Student will be able to earn a maximum of 50% credit on that assignment
  - Student will have up until the end of the current unit to turn in late assignment(s), after that it will be scored a zero

\* If you are ill/excused absent from school, you will need to turn in your assignment **the day you return** to school.

\* If you are absent from class for any reason, it is **your responsibility** to pick up any notes/handouts/assignments you may have missed.

\* **Come to class on time and prepared.** You will need to bring something to write with and a notebook. I suggest also bringing a folder specifically for health class.

\* Swearing or any inappropriate language is **not allowed** at any time in this class.

\* **Be respectful** of others at all times – this includes your classmates, teachers, substitute teachers, student teachers, or any other guests that come to this class.

\* **No food/drinks/gum/candy** allowed in class. The only exception is if the teacher has allowed it (health party, activity, skit, etc.)

\* If you need to use the **restroom/go to your locker/go to the office**, you must ask first and then take the hall pass with you.

\* **Cell Phones** – There may be times where we will use cell phones for classroom activities. If/when this would occur, a cell phone contract will be discussed in greater detail.

\* **Absolutely no cheating.** Any form of cheating will result in an automatic "F." (Remember, plagiarism = cheating)

\* **SmartBoards** – do not write on the boards with dry erase markers – only use the colored plastic pens that are in the pen trays.

\* **Discipline** – Any inappropriate behavior will not be accepted. One verbal warning will be given (except for severe cases). If behavior continues, a detention will be issued and parents will be notified. If behavior still continues, you will be removed from the classroom and a meeting with the principal will occur.

\* **You are responsible for your grade.** The more points you earn, the better your grade will be. So give your best effort at all times and your grade will take care of itself.
